**A RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO THE ENACTMENT OF A DEVELOPMENT MORATORIUM  
ORDINANCE**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Hampden may enact a development moratorium pursuant to Wis. Stat. §66.1002; and,





**WHEREAS**, the Town has received a written report from the Town Engineer containing the Town Engineer's opinion that data centers in the Town could create shortages, overburden public facilities, or pose significant threats to public health or safety that would justify the need for a moratorium.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Board of the Town of Hampden hereby finds that a moratorium is needed to prevent a shortage in, or the overburdening of, public facilities located in the Town, and also needed to address a significant threat to the public health or safety in the Town.

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Town Board shall consider a development moratorium ordinance for the development of Data Centers.
