Chairman Report:

The board to contract with Grothman & Associates for \$1000 to survey Cole Cemetery. The Board will collaborate with the neighboring owner to modify boundaries between lots and still maintain the same acreages.

Board members to attend a meeting with High Noon Solar and Columbia County highway dept on 8/21/24 Wednesday 11am at Wyocena garage. Discussion will focus on truck road access and routes used for construction. Tuschen to begin work on ordinances related to road access and right of way.

Planning Commission:

Tyler Bergstrom, surveyor representing Rusty and Kelli Selji, presented the land division - creating 2 four acre lots and deed restricting 72 acres from further residential development. Dahl made a motion to approve the CSM, declarations and covenants, and Hoffman seconded. Motion carried.

Road maintenance:

For future prevention of water damage,

Recently, Columbia County dug out the north side of Hall Road and Ostego Road to prevent future water damage.

The Board will request Columbia County to replace the 36" culvert with a 48" culvert at monson and bervam road.

John Jones to submit a \$150 bill for bobcat culvert work for reimbursement from the town.

Other Business:

Columbia County Planning and Zoning to change tourism ordinance and requesting feedback by 9/30/24. Will add to next month's agenda.

The Board to request snow removal bid to service problem dead-end roads. Dahl and Tuschen to meet with the vendor to visit the roads for bid. Will add to next months' agenda.
