Call to order:

Minutes:

Dahl approved the September meeting minutes. Seconded by Hoffman. Motion carried.

Treasurer Report:

Checking Account \$106,697.30

Government Pool Fund \$288,816.95

Total Funds \$395,514.25

Dahl made a motion to approve the treasurer report, Hoffman seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Chairman report:

Discussed Rio 2025 fire budget and allocation to Town of Hampden of \$12,499 (increased from \$11,688 in 2024). Board directors to attend Columbus Rural Fire 2025 budget meeting next week, October 24th at 7pm.

Plan commission:

none

Road maintenance:

The Board agreed to participate in round 2 application for the Agriculture Road Improvement Program (ARIP) for road maintenance for Bristol Road. The Town of Hampden section covers a few hundred yards between County Road N and A.

Received \$3K Emergency Management grants, but did not qualify for second grant since culverts covered under a different program.

Dahl made a motion to contract with TNT Lawn Care, LLC (Chad Theis) to plow/salt dead-end roads for 2025. Hoffman seconded the motion. Motion passes.

Discussion to provide documentation to obligate funds from American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). ARPA funds to be allocated, by priority- to shelter build, town hall air conditioner, with remaining funds to partially fund Columbus Rural Fire Group Fire truck.

Discussed 2025 town budget draft. Budget approval will be on the November agenda.

Dahl made a motion to adjourn. Hoffman seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned at 6:42pm.
