Town Board Meeting Jan 21st, 2025

Agenda/Meeting Notice Posted - Posted at the Hampden Town Hall, Sassy Cow, and Leeds/Hampden Recycling Center.

Call to Order - Chairman Tuschen called the meeting to order at Call to Order at 5:30pm.

Minutes - Hoffman made a motion to approve minutes from the December meeting. Seconded by Dahl. Motion passes.

Caucus results – all incumbents were nominated and there were no other candidates.

Road Maintenance - The Board reviewed the details associated with the most recent county road bill for \$64,596.11.

Tuschen is working with the county to add a flashing stop sign at the intersection of Hwy N and DM/K due to the several accidents at that location. The county board will review the request in March.

There was discussion about the right-of-way ordinance for companies that bury lines within the town. There is consideration to charge fees to cover the cost of potential landscape repairs.

Chairman Report

37,000 acres of land is identified for wind covering Ostego, Leeds, Lowville, Fall River and Hampden and surrounding areas. The wind station will be in Fall River. Forms will be sent to government agencies (FAA, DNR, etc) for approval. The final map should be available in April/May.

There is a Rio Fire & EMS meeting tomorrow. They will report on the status of assuming partial coverage of the Pardeeville area.

There are upcoming WTA annual meetings. Dahl and Hoffman will attend the in-person meeting in Beaver Dam on 3/29/25. Hensen will attend the online meetings on 3/17-3/18/25.

Plan Commission - The Columbia County zoning meeting on 1/7/25 approved the Sharpee zoning change. The Board received an amending County ordinance letter. Hensen will scan and email the Plan Commission.

Other Business

Related to the ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act), the 2025 report will be available on the SLRF portal late March and due 4/30/25. There was an email dated 1/10/25 with additional guidance validating the reporting timeline and with updated FAQs. Hensen set up security access in preparation for reporting.

Recent notifications of grants were reviewed and deemed not applicable. The Wisconsin housing survey was completed on 1/20/25 with no new houses in 2024. Hoffman to complete the Farmland Preservation, which is due 3/1/25. There will be a primary election on 2/18/25 for State Superintendent.

Hoffman made a motion to adjourn. Dahl seconded the motion. Meeting adjourned at 6:21pm.
