**Call to Order** - Chairman Tuschen called the meeting to order at Call to Order at 5:30pm.

**Roll call** - Town board members present - Chairman Tuschen, Supervisor Taylor Dahl, Supervisor Bill Hoffman, Clerk Nanette Hensen and Treasurer Lori Toutant. In addition, Citizens - Tony Trapp, Ann Plata, Beth Ann McKenzie, Steven Pederson, Greg and Veronica Keip were present.

**Citizen Comments/Correspondents/Announcements -**

- Wind tower ordinance –
  - Reviewed and discussed wind tower ordinance -
    - Timing to pass ordinance during this meeting is critical since Alliant will submit sites in early November.
    - Amendments to follow
    - Ordinance language was adjusted from prior version to adhere to state laws as to not be subsequently overturned.
    - Citizen Noise concerns
      - state law not restrictive enough for noise
      - Per state law, noise is controlled by -
        - Setback 1250 feet or 3x height
        - Sound restrictions
    - Citizen can testify at Public Service Commission (PSC) Badger Hollow Wind Project to voice opinions and concerns

    - 2 changes -
      - Permit fee - \$500 per turbine
      - #7 Decommissioning - substitute state law 128.19 decommissioning language
    - Tuschen made a motion to approve the wind tower ordinance with the 2 changes. Seconded by Dahl. Hoffman abstains. Motion passes.
  - Wind tower task force
    - Members - Ann Plata, Tony Trapp, Greg Keip, Veronica Keip
    - Purpose is to review the wind tower ordinance more thoroughly and recommend amendments to the town board.
    - Volunteer positions
    - The task force will setup meetings and invite clerk to take notes.
    - Amendments will be reviewed during the November Board meeting.

- 2026 Preliminary Budget was reviewed.
  - 2025 Levy \$199,969 is the same as last year.
  - The Board reviewed breakdown of board expenses since unfavorable deviation the last 2 years.
  - Increased election costs with 4 elections, increase hourly wage for poll workers, and election training
    - Planning several in-person election training for poll workers.
  - Restricted funds - Columbus fire truck, park shelter (added costs for picnic tables, lighting and walkway) and additional town road maintenance.
  - Upcoming November board meeting approvals - Budget, Levy, Memo of Understanding for WisVote Services.

#### Chairman Report -

- Hall road cemetery paperwork complete
- Columbus Fire Board meeting next Thursday to finalize budget
- Columbus ambulance contract finalized
- Pre-disaster Flood Resilience Grant does not apply
- Reviewed Town of Hampden Cemetery ordinance (to approve in November Board meeting).
- Locks added to closet within interior room to further secure election equipment
- Park shelter status
  - Likely to be completed this year
  - Added lighting and walkway from town hall building to shelter to provide for wheelchair access
- Tuschen and clerk signed 2025-2027 Bruce Gardiner Appraisal contract.
- Tile work needed to town hall entrance. Dahl will research contractors.

#### Road Maintenance -

- Hoffman makes a motion to approve road ratings and miles. Seconded by Dahl. Motion passes.
- Wisconsin DOT general transportation aid \$124,114.80 for 2026.
- Columbia county bill reviewed.
